

## **SPECIAL WASTE**

---

The landfill will accept some waste with special condition and handling. Below are examples of special waste:

- Petroleum Contaminated Soil
- Construction and Demolition Debris
- Asbestos Waste
- Wastewater Sludge
- Incinerator and Boiler Ash

## **WASTE REJECTION & INSPECTION**

---

The Authority can reject any load of waste if the waste is deemed unacceptable by the landfill personnel. If the waste is dumped at the working area, it must be reloaded and returned to the generator at the generator's expense.

All loads are subject to inspection to ensure that the waste acceptance criteria have been met. The generator is subject to additional handling fees and repair cost incurred by the landfill for handling unacceptable waste or unapproved special waste

## **SALVAGING & SCAVENGING**

---

Salvaging and scavenging is strictly **prohibited**. The hauler (driver) is allowed out of his vehicle in the working area only to facilitate discharge of the waste if necessary.

## **RECYCLING**

---

Contact your County or Solid Waste Departments to discuss recycling options in your area.

## **BILLING**

---

The member counties will bill haulers for disposal of waste generated in their county. Waste generated outside of the region or waste accepted under a direct delivery agreement will be billed directly by the Authority. Contact us at (803) 652-2225 for credit approval prior to delivery.

# THREE RIVERS REGIONAL LANDFILL DELIVERY INFORMATION

## WASTE ACCEPTANCE HOURS

## HOLIDAYS & EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

Closed New Year's Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, Labor Day,  
Thanksgiving Day, & Christmas Day

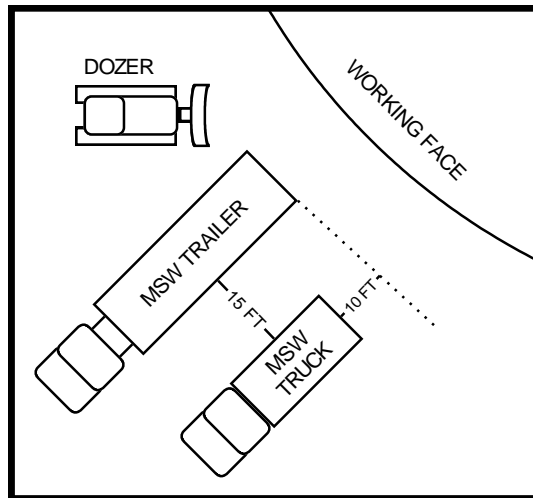
Other holidays and closings will be posted at  
the scales and the transfer stations will be  
notified.

The hauler will be notified by the gate attendant  
in the event of emergency closures and  
lightning delays. Trucks must stop at the  
maintenance area during lightning storms.

## GENERAL RULES

- All delivery vehicles must be in good working condition.
- All delivery vehicles must be self-unloading.
- All vehicles must obey posted speed limits.
- All vehicles must be equipped with tow hooks.
- All vehicles must obey landfill personnel direction.
- No weapons allowed on the property.
- Only the driver may exit the vehicle, if necessary, and must wear high visibility clothing meeting at least ANSI 1 & safety boots.
- No passengers are allowed outside of vehicle, but they must still wear high visibility clothing meeting at least ANSI 1 & safety boots.
- No one under the influence of alcohol, controlled substances, or medication that impairs ability to operate heavy equipment is allowed on the premises.
- No alcohol or controlled substances are allowed on the premises.

- All loads must be tarped or enclosed until arrival at the dumping area and before leaving the dumping area.
- Trucks discharging waste must be at least 15 feet apart or as directed by landfill personnel.
- Trucks discharging waste must stay at least 10 feet from the rear of a discharging waste trailer.



- No children beyond the scale house unless approved by the Landfill Manager and accompanied by an adult.
- No driving off the maintained roads unless discharging waste.
- No smoking except in designated areas.
- All accidents must be reported immediately to the landfill manager or operator.
- Due to conditions of landfill operations & lack of properly equipped tires on vehicles, there may be times that vehicles become stuck & may need assistance. The driver must request assistance for towing. The driver is responsible for the vehicle and any damages that may result and will be asked to sign a waiver. The driver will be responsible for hooking the truck to the landfill equipment. TRSWA deserves the right to deny assistance due to safety concerns.
- Any delivery vehicle damage incurred during waste discharge that may have been caused by Three Rivers Landfill employees must be

reported to the landfill manager before leaving the site & an incident report completed.

- No loitering.
- Any suspicious or inappropriate activities should be reported immediately to landfill personnel.
- No scavenging.

Non-compliance with these rules may result in removal from the premises, revocation of delivery rights, fines, and/or additional fees as posted.

## WEIGHING

The gross weight of all vehicles must be recorded at the scale house prior to entering the working area of the landfill. After discharging calculate the net waste volume.

Tare weights can be established for vehicles that make frequent deliveries. The hauler is responsible for notifying the gate attendant if the tare weight changes due to vehicle modification. Tare weight must be checked at least annually or when prompted by the hauler.

## TRAFFIC FLOW

Waste haulers must obey all traffic signs. The dumping area will be designated with signs, curbs, personnel, and/or the gate attendant will direct the hauler to the appropriate location for the waste. Haulers and generators are subject to additional fees if waste is discharged in an area not designated by landfill personnel.

## ACCEPTABLE WASTE

The landfill will accept the following:

- Residential Waste
- Commercial Waste
- Institutional Waste
- Industrial Waste

## UNACCEPTABLE WASTE

The landfill will NOT accept the following:

- Hazardous Waste
- Explosive Waste
- Bio-Hazardous or Infectious Waste
- Tires
- White Goods
- Raw Sewage
- Non-washed Chemical Containers
- Radiological Waste
- E-Waste
- Yard Waste
- Bulky Waste
- PCB Waste
